Kidztown Ministries: Children's programming will take place in our special children's area that we are now calling "Kidztown".

Kidz will have fun learning about God with interactive Bible teaching in both sessions. Specifically, the 9:00 session will be more akin to Sunday school, with "Kidzchurch" at the 10:40 session.

Ark Avenue:

Nursery is provided throughout the morning. The nursery department goes up to 2 years old rooms 207 & 209 respectively

Park Place Kidz

Kidz 3 & 4 years old will rotate between rooms 203 & 204 for centers & Bible lesson time.

Downtown Drive Kidz

5 & 6 year olds will meet in rooms 205 & 206 for centers & Bible lesson time.

Uptown Blvd. Kidz Kidz 1st - 4th Grade will have the hallway with rooms 301-311

For the 1st - 4th Grade please note:

1. If your children will be attending the entire morning, you may drop them off at their SS class rooms and pick them up from Kidzchurch after the 10:40 session.
2. Between sessions, children will be engaging in a time of fellowship where they can also work on computers or portfolios in the Kidztown area. This is where children can be picked up or dropped off between sessions.
3. The 10:40 session will actually begin in the main Worship Center (with the adults). Teachers will escort the kids to a reserved area and after a portion of the service the teachers will escort the kids back to the Kidzchurch area of Kidztown. The area reserved for the kids will be in the "back, right-hand" corner (southeast) of the Worship Center.
4. If children are attending the 10:40 session only, and are arriving only at that time or just a few minutes prior, they should go directly to the main Worship Center where they will meet up with the other kids coming in with teachers. They will easily fold into the group at that point.
