

**Behold His Glory: Behold the Light of the World!**  
**Sermon # 14, John 8:12-30**

**Main Point:** *Follow Jesus as the Light of the World, and He'll rescue you from darkness.*

**Getting to Know You**

1. Tell a story of how you were scared of the dark as a child (or now 😊). What did your parents do to take away your fear?

**Getting into the Book:**

**Read John 8:12-30**

2. How does the historical setting give greater impact to Jesus' words? (Setting: He spoke these words during the Feast of Tabernacles in the Court of Women, where large candelabras gave off light which could be seen throughout the city.)
3. Refer to the following verses to discover what other announcements Jesus was making with His words:
  - a. Isaiah 43:10-11
  - b. Exodus 13:21-22
  - c. Isaiah 42:6
4. Why don't people today believe that Jesus is the Light of the world? (See John 8:19, 23, 24 for hints)
5. What does it mean for people to walk in the darkness? (See John 3:19-20)

**Getting Out There**

6. What does Jesus mean when He says "follow Me"? (See John 10:27) Based on this definition, how are you doing with following Jesus?
7. Give a practical example of how following Jesus has rescued you from walking in darkness?
8. What evidence is there in your life that you have "the Light of life"?
9. What's the name of a non-Christian friend with whom you will share the verse John 8:12? When will you do it?

**Pray**

Praise Jesus for being the Light of the world, and for rescuing you from darkness. Pray that your family and friends will also follow Him as the Light of the world.
