## Psalm 119 Reading Plan

While not evident in English, each of the eight lines in the 22 stanzas, begins with the same letter of the alphabet. Psalm 119 is a masterpiece extolling the word of God and describing its tremendous benefits. May you too come to love the word of God with the same affection as the Psalmist!

Use this Bible reading plan to study, reflect, and even memorize meaningful verses. After every five days of reading, there are two reflection days built in, to allow you time to review what you've read and spend more time thinking about meaningful verses. Having a pen and notepad with you each day is encouraged, so you can underline key verses and/or record your insights.
