Case Study:

2. What is Jesus' command in John 13:34?
3. Read Deuteronomy 10:12-13. Who are you ultimately serving? Why?

The World:

1. How does Jesus set the standard for us in serving others?
2. Read Matthew 20:28. How does this Scripture encourage you to live differently from the rest of the world?
3. What are the world's standards of greatness?

The Application:

1. Read Philippians 2:3-5. What is the secret to having a servant's heart?
2. What are some small steps you can take to walk as Jesus walked?
3. In what ways can your family group serve one another?

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How to use this guide:

- **Study and discuss the passage**, not necessarily the outline of the sermon
