

**“The Commitments of a Viral Community”**

**Acts 2:42-47**

**Main Point: People who are truly Christians are part of the family of God and will be committed to doing church with one another. The result will be a community that is alive and multiplying.**

3. How would you outline Acts 2:42-47?
4. Why do you think it is important for us to start with understanding who the “they” of Acts 2:42 are? What are some of the dangers of seeking to disciple a person who has never really become a child of God?
5. Describe the picture that this passage gives us of the early church. What items are prescriptive? Which are descriptive?
6. What kind of devotion do you see in verse 42?

**Application:**

7. How do we apply the devotion of Acts 2:42 to our lives in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century?
8. Do you ever feel alone? How can our Family Group properly apply Acts 2:42-47 to help?
9. How do we avoid the danger of making “church” (Attending Sunday worship, Community Groups or Family Groups) a legalistic ritual?
10. How is God multiplying our group? Is there anything that we are or are not doing that is impeding the work of the Holy Spirit in using this group to impact others for Christ?
