Look Back

Look Up (Use Genesis 21:8-21 to answer these questions. Leader's note: For context, read Genesis 16):

1. Why were Hagar and Ishmael sent away?
2. What did God tell Abraham before he sent away Hagar and Ishmael away?
3. When did Hagar call out to God? How did God respond?
4. What happened to Ishmael?

Look Forward:

1. How will your awareness of God's all-knowing nature influence you as you reach out to others?
2. What sorts of things can you expect to happen when you trust God's plan?
3. When will you make time to share the message of God's love with others this week?

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How to use this guide:

- **Study and discuss the passage**, not necessarily the outline of the sermon
- Don't feel pressure to ask all the questions, use your discernment based on time and needs of the group
- Engage the mind with good doctrine and move to the heart pushing toward application (A Key diagnostic for the leader to discern the health of his group is to listen "heart" conversation.
