Luke 19:28-44

Main Point: Jesus is our Savior King deserving wholehearted worship.

Getting to Know You: Have you ever been near someone famous but didn't recognize them?

Looking Back:

1. How did you do in accomplishing your goals since last time we met?
2. Did anyone take the opportunity to share the gospel with a non-Christian, or disciple a Christian? Tell us about it.

Looking Up: Read Luke 19:28-44

3. What does it teach us about Jesus that He was making His way to Jerusalem? See also Luke 9:51; 13:31-33; 18:31-34.
4. For what reasons did Jesus choose to ride into Jerusalem on a donkey? See Zechariah 9:9.
5. How did the crowd respond to Jesus? How did the Pharisees respond to Jesus?
6. What was Jesus' point when He answered the Pharisees the way He did?
7. What's in store for those who fail to recognize Jesus as King? Have *you* chosen to worship King Jesus?

Looking Ahead

8. Who do you know who needs help understanding Jesus as Savior King?
9. In light of this passage, in what way(s) is the Holy Spirit speaking to you as to how to respond this week?

Pray: Pray for your loved ones who need to know Jesus as Savior King.

<u>What Questions do I have for my Family Group?</u>	<u>Key Cross References:</u>
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How to use this guide:

- **Study and discuss the passage**, not necessarily the outline of the sermon
- Don't feel pressure to ask all the questions, use your discernment based on time and needs of the group
- Engage the mind with good doctrine and move to the heart pushing toward application (A key diagnostic for the leader to discern the health of his group is to listen "heart" conversation.)
- Designate a group member to record the spiritual goals of the group, so you can hold each other accountable each meeting.
